YMCA Youth & Government provides financial assistance to the extent possible to those in need. Proof of income is required and eligibility is determined by comparing your gross annual household income to the Housing & Urban Development (HUD) Income Guidelines for King County. We also take into consideration the number of people supported by your income. Once submitted, your application will be reviewed and you will be notified within one week. Assistance will be granted on a first come, first serve basis. Assistance will be granted for the duration of the program year. You can reapply to receive continued assistance in the following year.
