### Facility Memberships

A **YMCA of Greater Seattle Membership** allows unlimited use of 11 different membership facilities, including most health & wellness classes and programs. Specialty classes and programs with fees are offered at a lower rate to members.

You can visit as often as you like, take classes, use the facilities and equipment, and pay one low monthly fee. Your satisfaction is guaranteed and there are no long-term commitments required. At the West Seattle location, towels are available at no extra charge; personal kit lockers are available for an additional monthly fee.

A **Local Facility Membership** allows unlimited access to the Fauntleroy location, including most health & wellness classes and programs, and three visits per month to the West Seattle location.

Membership rates include a one-time joining fee and annual membership dues. These dues can be paid entirely upon joining, or monthly via electronic transfer – a bank draft from an authorized checking or savings account.

### Puget Sound Triangle Membership

A Triangle Membership gives you the flexibility of unlimited use of more than 25 YMCAs in the Puget Sound region. Check at the Membership Desk for a brochure of the participating YMCAs and their facilities.

### Program Membership

Everyone who participates at the YMCA must be a member, but not everyone needs a Facility Membership. Program Memberships are available for participants in swim lessons, youth sports, child care, day camp, etc. Program members pay an annual membership fee, plus the program member rate for the YMCA program you're registering for.

**Annual Program Membership:** Allows an individual or a family to sign up for unlimited programs at all our locations for a 12-month period at the program member rate.

**Individual \$35 Family \$70**

**Single Session Program Membership:** Allows an individual or a family to sign-up for one session of one program, at one location at the program membership rate.

**Individual \$15 Family \$30**

### Daily Membership

Want to try before you buy, or just stopping in for the day? Buy a daily membership and sample the facilities. Up to three daily receipts can be applied to a Facility Membership when you choose to join. (Receipts must be presented to the Membership Staff when you join.) Valid photo ID is required for daily members age 15 and up. Daily Memberships for families are available for two adults and up to three children ages 17 and under. See rates below.

You may ask for a confidential assistance application at Member Services. All YMCA members receive the same membership benefits, regardless of financial assistance.

## Satisfaction Guaranteed

If, within 30 days of joining the YMCA, you are not completely satisfied with your membership for any reason, we will refund your joining fee.

## Cancellation & Refund Policy

All schedules, activities, class fees and staff may be changed or cancelled by the YMCA without notice. We will give you a full refund if we cancel a program. Credit will be given for consecutive days of illness which cause you to miss more than half a session (written verification from a physician required). Credit is 60% of the cost of the missed classes. Credit may not be applied to membership fees. To receive a refund (minus \$5 handling fee), participants must cancel their enrollment in a class by the Wednesday before the first day of the session.

Note: Express Swim Registration fees are nonrefundable and not transferable.

## Insurance Disclaimer

It is the member's or participant's responsibility to provide his or her own accident and health insurance. The YMCA does not provide any such coverage for members or participants.

## Returned Checks

A \$25 service fee is charged on all returned checks and automatic bank drafts not honored by your bank for any reason.
