

# FACT SHEET

## YMCA OF GREATER SEATTLE

The YMCA of Greater Seattle has a rich 132-year history of providing valuable programs and services to King and south Snohomish counties. From preschool to older adult activities, we provide programs and services geared to the individual needs of the communities we reach. Three important community needs drive these programs and services: successful youth, strong families and healthy lifestyles.

### SUCCESSFUL YOUTH

- In greater Seattle, YMCAs serve nearly 2,500 in preschool child care and elementary school activity programs.
- YMCA Camp Orkila and YMCA Camp Colman serve 3,750 kids annually in summer camp, as well as 7,475 in Outdoor Environmental Education programs.
- 21 youth development directors provide positive programs and caring adult role models for 25,000 youth and teens annually.
- Through YMCA programs, 6,700 youth/young adults achieve success in employment, foster care, transitional housing and alternative education programs.

### STRONG FAMILIES

- Family Nights offer welcoming, supportive and enriching opportunities for family members of all ages, with 64,000 visits per year.
- Parent/Child Programs (Y-Adventure Guides) build strong bonds for 5,100 family members.
- Family Camps and Parent/Child Program weekends provide unique connections for 689 parents and children.
- Family financial literacy classes serve more than 787 participants per year.

### HEALTHY LIFESTYLES

- Instructional aquatics and fitness, including our Strong Kids and Strong Teens partnership with Children's Hospital, help 18,700 participants develop healthier lifestyles.
- Youth sports programs provide the opportunity for 9,000 participants to engage in meaningful physical activity.
- 7,700 older adult members of all ages, abilities and fitness levels, participate in weekly health, fitness and social activities.
