# FALL SEMESTER REGISTRATION FORM

Students are enrolled for the entire semester and will be accepted at any time on a space available basis. Classes are held at the Snoqualmie Methodist Church and are based on the Snoqualmie Valley School District calendar. Payment is made prior to participation, either in full or by monthly installments using a recurring credit card charge. **Two weeks written notice is required for all changes or cancellations.** All participants must have a YMCA membership. Financial assistance to the extent possible is made available through YMCA Partners with Youth Campaign and United Way Funding. Everyone is welcome at the YMCA.

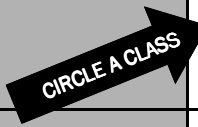
## ENROLLMENT PROCEDURES:
