The Details

Lodging:

Lodging options will include the Dederer Center, Wally Fisher Lodge, Training Center and Smith cabin. The Wally Fisher Lodge has 4 bedrooms each sleeping 12 people with communal bathrooms located in the building. The Training Center is located below the dining hall and consists of 4 bedroom each sleeping 4 people with communal bathrooms located in the building. Smith cabin has two rooms, each sleeping 10 people with communal bathrooms in the building. Each Dederer Center cabin has 4 bedrooms each sleeping 4 people, a full kitchen, a living room and 2 private bathrooms. There may be more than one family or group of volunteers in a cabin. We will do our best to accommodate you in the cabin of your choice.

Meals:

Regular meals will begin Saturday morning with the last meal being a sack lunch on Sunday. We will provide dinner for volunteers who arrive Friday before 5pm.

Transportation:

We will be picking volunteers up from the Orcas Ferry landing for the 3:30 pm and 5:45 pm sailing from Anacortes. On Sunday we will shuttle volunteers to the ferry at 10:25 am and 12:40 pm. Please let us know which ferry you will be taking when you sign up. You may also drive your personal vehicle to camp. *Please note that ferry times may change seasonally.*

Who can attend:

Families are welcome to attend, however childcare and recreational programming is not provided. Please, no unaccompanied minors.
