Financial Assistance

The YMCA is a membership organization open to all people. If you cannot afford the full cost of a YMCA program or membership, please ask for a confidential financial assistance application. Auburn School District provides transportation from Lakeland Hills Elementary.

Classes that start at 5:00pm

If your child is only attending a 5:00pm class, please arrange to have them dropped off at 5:00 pm.

Late Policy

You must pick your child up at the end of your child's last class. For example, if your child's last class ends at 5pm you must pick them up at this time. There is a five minute grace periods before being considered late. You will be asked to register for the next period if being late becomes an issue. Refusal may result in suspension or termination without refund or credit if late pick up continues. If you are late, your child will sit in a class for supervision purposes, but will not be allowed to participate in a class.

Snow and Inclement Weather Policy

- If the Auburn Public Schools are closed due to snow or inclement weather, Kids' University will be closed.
- If the Auburn Public Schools send students home midday due to snow or inclement weather, Kids' University will be closed.
- If the Auburn School District is delayed then the site will be equally delayed. For example if they are 2 hours late then the site will open 2 hours late.
- If there is inclement weather during a break, such as winter break, you will be notified by 5:30 am that we intend to close the site.

Special Needs

- ☺ Other people's property.

Responsibility

- ☺ Be responsible for your actions and your things.
- ☺ Clean up after yourself – throw your trash away and pick up mishaps.
- ☺ Put everything back where it belongs.
- ☺ You are responsible for the loss, damage to, and damage inflicted by your personal items that you bring to the program.

Caring

- ☺ Share with others
- ☺ Exit all classrooms, activity areas, and other facilities in a quiet and orderly manner.

Honesty

- ☺ Be honest with yourself, your parents, YMCA staff, and other YMCA participants.
- ☺ Talk to a staff member about conflicts with others.
- ☺ Do not bring any of the following:
 - ⊗ Weapons (real or fake)
 - ⊗ Drugs
 - ⊗ Alcohol/Tobacco
 - ⊗ Money
 - ⊗ Valuable toys and cards (including Walkman, Gameboys, CDs, etc)

Faith

- ☺ Believe in each other's capabilities and help each other grow by learning new experiences.
- ☺ Be willing to try new things to broaden your experiences (ex: sleep away from home, climb a climbing wall, roller skate, etc)

Fun

- ☺ Participate in all activities.
- ☺ Have fun and encourage others to have fun.

Class Descriptions

Monday-Friday 6-8:30 am

AM Rec Time Homework checks, recreational activities, computer, snack, and group discussion time

Monday-Friday 3:15-4:00

Join us as we make a healthy snack and have a group discussion about the current issues and concerns of the students and staff. This is also used as homework time.

Monday 4:00—5:00 PM

Drawing: This class covers the basic fundamentals of drawing including the use of lines, shape, light and shadow. Children will draw based on observations and creative expression in a variety of mediums.

Tutoring: We will be helping with reading, math, spelling and homework during this hour. Activities are tailored to support the curriculum used in the schools. K-2nd Grade

Pottery: From sculptures to dishes children will have the chance to make an array of creations out of clay and learn different sculpting techniques

Monday 5:00—6:00 PM

Tutoring: We will be helping with reading, math, spelling and/or homework during this hour. Activities are tailored to support the curriculum used in the schools. 3rd-5th Grade

Getting Crafty: Beading, painting, sewing, cutting, pasting and so much more! This class gives students the opportunity to experience all forms of arts and crafts.

Tuesday 4:00—5:00 PM

Painting: From still-life to landscapes and acrylics to finger-paints. This class will submerge you into the world of painting. Children will learn about different periods of painting and different painters in addition to creating their own masterpieces through the semester.

Cooking 101: 4-6pm At the Auburn YMCA. Children will learn cooking basics like measurements and nutrition while creating their own culinary masterpieces. They will end the session with a cookbook containing all the recipes they learned and created. Only 14 spaces available

Community Connections: In this weekly class children will meet and create ways to connect with the community. Through service learning projects, involvement with the school, and other fun activities the children will feel like they are apart of their community.

Tuesday 5:00—6:00 PM

Group Games: In this class children will build skills in teamwork, communication, and physical education as they work together and individually to complete challenges. Both indoor and outdoor activities.

Magic of Science: Make things swing, pop, grow, shrink and explode while exploring the crazy world of science. Every week you'll perform or create your very own science experiment.

Wednesday 4:00—5:00 PM

Aerobics/Fitness: Get your blood pumping and your feet moving in this high energy fitness class. Enjoy using weights, yoga balls and other fitness equipment while building a strong healthy body.

Tutoring: We will be helping with reading, math, spelling and homework during this hour. Activities are tailored to support the curriculum used in the schools. K-2nd Grade

Outdoor Activity Skills: 4-6pm Location varies with activity. Subject to weather conditions. Learn archery, rock wall climbing, the Alpine Tower and a variety of other skills needed for safe outdoor activities. Only 14 spaces available

Wednesday 5:00—6:00 PM

Tutoring: We will be helping with reading, math, spelling and/or homework during this hour. Activities are tailored to support the curriculum used in the schools. 3rd-5th Grade

Kid's U News: Extra! Extra! Read all about it! Students dive head first into the world of journalism

Thursday 4:00—5:00 PM

Swimming:4-6pm At the Auburn YMCA Busy schedule? Why not get swimming lessons out of the way while you are at work! Only 14 spaces available

Creation Station: If you have ever wanted to build things, this is the class for you! Each class will focus on building motor skills through the construction of objects. The students will be using Lego's, K'nex and other manipulatives to construct everything under the sun.

Team Sports: This class cycles through a number of team sports and like soccer and basketball in an effort to build teamwork and sportsmanship.

Thursday 5:00—6:00 PM

Board Games & Puzzles: We're going to get back to basics. Each week, we'll focus on strategies and the ideas of all the classics. Whether it be Monopoly, Chess, Battleship or Life; this class will have something for everyone. We will also be putting together puzzles!

Planet Earth: Learn about the amazing planet we live on region by region. From plants and animals to land formations, this class is based on the Discovery Channel's series Planet Earth.

Friday 4:00—5:00 PM

Jeopardy: Trivia anyone? Students will work their brains playing the ultimate trivia game. This class will enable students to show off their knowledge in a variety of subjects. Thinking caps required!

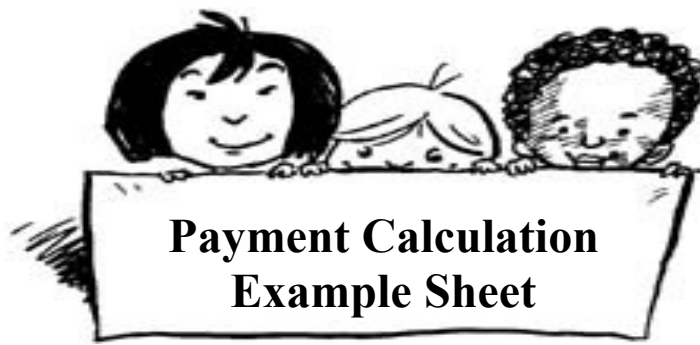
Party Planning: Everyone loves a party, now it's your turn to plan one! Learn the art of party planning from creating invitations to decorating to hosting to clean up.

Gym Games: How about some spider ball or dodge ball? Students enrolled in this class will get the opportunity to play all sorts of gym games in this safe non competitive environment.

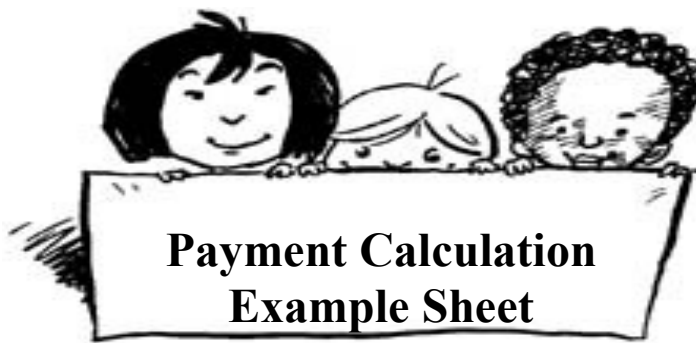
Computer Skill Building: Children will build their computer skills by learning to navigate through computer programs. They will be learning new skills and enhancing the ones they already have.

Morning class $\$175 \times 3 \text{ days} = \525

3:15-4 pm class $\$75 \times 5 \text{ days} = \375

Add all other classes

$110 + 240 + 110 + 110 + 120 + 110 + 110 + 110 = \1020

Add all totals together and divide by 5 monthly payments in a semester

$1020 + 525 + 375 = \$1920$

$1920 / 5 = \$384$ a month + any half day and/or no school day fees

1/2 Days \$15 a day

No School days \$35 a day
