FAMILY SUPPORT PROGRAMS



PARENT YOUTH CONNECTION SEMINARS

Our caring staff work with young people and their families to stop behavior that puts young people at-risk. Our Parent Youth Connection Seminars support youth who have committed a first crime and their parents or caregivers by providing tools and resources that build up trust and understanding. Workshops promote positive choices and prevent future criminal involvement.



CHILDREN'S CRISIS OUTREACH RESPONSE SYSTEM (CCORS)

CCORS is a 24/7 support system that helps young people and their families going through a crisis. Trained interventionists work with families to provide short-term solutions and tools to help work through complex issues like suicide or violent behavior. Families develop the skills to improve communication, understand warning signs, and be more prepared when a dangerous situation arises.



FOSTER CARE

Our dedicated staff provide a bridge to nurturing, permanent homes by offering safe and loving foster homes, along with personalized support and intervention based on the unique needs of each child and family. We are also partners in Commercial Sexual Exploitation of Children (CSEC), a King County foster care program designed to serve youth who have been commercially sexually exploited.



PERMANENCY

Trained counselors work with families and children at risk of being placed in temporary foster homes to find permanent housing and guardian solutions. Families develop coping skills and tools to improve family relations and support the well-being of the child.



40% of young people who exited our therapeutic foster care program were reunited with their biological families.



89% of youth referred to CCORS because of an unstable living situation were able to remain in their home or return to a stable living situation after receiving services.
